Erasmus+ is the EU programme for education, training, youth and sport in Europe.



### What activities can I apply for?

Academic studies (one semester) and intership (2–12 month)









### Conditions of application

There are several conditions for applying. It is important to note, however, that students who have been awarded a Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship are not eligible to apply for an Erasmus scholarship.

#### HUNGARIAN CITIZENSHIP

Or residence permit.

#### ACTIVE STUDENT STATUS AT WESLEY

Erasmus semester can not be a passive semester, but you can still go for an internship after the graduation, but you must apply before.

#### Cover letter

- What is the professional relevance of the programme for the applicant?
- Why is it worthwhile to complete the programme in the country and institution of your choice, and what advantages does it offer compared to its domestic counterpart?
- What are the professional and career implications and impacts of the programme for the applicant?
- Include in your cover letter if you are involved in any community activities at Wesley College (e.g., Student government)

## What's the plan?

## Study plan/work plan

Study plan: a plan of the courses and other activities for the semester abroad, submitted in English and in the language of the course. These can be found on the universities' websites.

Work plan: a plan for the placement abroad, describing the activities to be carried out in English and in the working language of the placement.



#### **INTERVIEW**

The Erasmus Committee of the College invites all applicants who meet the criteria to an interview. The interview will be conducted in English and in the language of the training/practical course.

#### **NOTIFICATION**

After the interview, the Commission will inform you in writing whether you have been successful in the programme.







### INTERNSHIP

You can apply for an internship lasting 2–12 months.

It is also possible to apply for an internship after graduation, but the application must be made before the final exams and an active student status is required.



### INTERNSHIP

Applications for internships are always open.

Several types of learning mobility are possible within one study cycle.

Applicants must find their own institution before applying.

A Learning Agreement must be signed with the selected institution. After that, the application can be submitted by email and will be assessed by the Erasmus Committee.



### INTERNSHIP

If the student receives an internship salary from the company, the grant is still payable.

The host party can check the student's language skills. For example, you can ask for a language test certificate or take a test.
